



A Course for Inpatient Nurses

Program Description

Target Audience

Unlike other trauma care programs targeted at prehospital and emergency care providers, the **Trauma Care After Resuscitation (TCAR)** course is designed specifically for acute care, critical care, and perioperative nurses. This 2-day educational offering gives inpatient staff members the evidence-based foundational information and critical thinking skills necessary to meet regulatory requirements for trauma center designation and provide excellent care to this challenging patient population.



Course Overview

Day 1 focuses on concepts relevant to the nursing care of the hospitalized trauma patient:

- The trauma continuum of care
- The biomechanics of trauma
- The body's response to injury
- Assessment of the traumatically injured patient
- Caring for the patient in shock

Day 2 consists of case study modules focussed on the care of hospitalized patients with injuries to various body regions. Each case is designed to introduce specific concepts in trauma care including pathophysiology, assessment modalities, and complications. Surgical, medical, and nursing management options and outcome criteria are discussed. Learners will participate in guided, interactive discussions regarding the care of patients with:

- Thoracic trauma
- Abdominal trauma
- Musculoskeletal trauma
- Head trauma
- Spinal cord trauma
